The East African Smoke Free Program (EASFP) works to reduce the harm caused by tobacco and secondhand smoke among Somali and East African children, youth, and adults through innovative community awareness and health education activities that change social norms around tobacco use.

6,000 residents at Riverside Plaza are now living in smoke-free housing

Almost 3,000 people were directly reached and 77,761 were indirectly reached through community outreach activities.

Eliminating Health Disparities Initiative

The Eliminating Health Disparities Initiative (EHDI) is working with the Somali community to build the skills necessary to prevent diabetes, heart disease, and stroke. The EHDI program also hosts the Minnesota Community Health Worker (CHW) Peer Network, and provides continuing education opportunities for Minnesota's diverse CHWs.

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Reproductive Health: The Somali Child Spacing Program and the Karen Family Planning Program

The Somali Child Spacing Program and the Karen Family Planning Program provide culturally appropriate reproductive health education and resources to both the Somali and Karen communities, and to health care providers serving these communities. Grounded in a health benefits, client-centered approach, Somali and Karen Community Health Workers (CHWs) assist Somali and Karen men and women to understand their reproductive health options, and how to access resources and care. Staff also work with providers to increase their culture sensitivity, which improves their work with their Somali and Karen patients.

CHWs educated 29 men and 200 women in the Somali community about the benefits of child spacing, family planning methods, local clinics and resources, and partner communication approaches.

Staff from WellShare and the Karen Organization of Minnesota (KOM) partnered to develop and implement a holistic reproductive health curriculum in the Karen community.

Scaling-up Distribution of Depo in Uganda

The Scaling-up Community-based Distribution of Depot Medroxyprogesterone Acetate (Depo) in Uganda project, funded by USAID, worked to increase contraceptive options for women in rural communities of Sembabule District, Uganda. Objectives of this project include increasing access to family planning services, improving quality of family planning services in health centers and communities, and providing technical assistance to other community-based organization partners in Community Based Family Planning.
